OVERVIEW

Maiden Erlegh School has a resource base for students with an EHCP and a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) requiring a high level of support to access mainstream curricular They also receive Social Emotional and Mental Health support.

The Resource Base has the benefit of a separate building based on the school site, containing specialist SEN classrooms, dedicated workspaces, therapy rooms, sensory rooms and direct access to the school playing fields. Students will spend between 20 - 80% of their time in mainstream lessons with a high level of adult support. Five spaces are allocated each year. Placement is via a consultation process through Wokingham Borough Council SEN Team and a panel meeting.
